
## sexually exploited children

Abducted, tricked through the promise of a good job, exploited because of disabilities, or even sold by their own parents, these children suffer exposure to AIDS, beatings, deprivation, and other abuse by those who enslave them.

Our recovery centers offer medical treatment and counseling to help overcome their physical and emotional trauma. # Their plight.

Every 15 seconds another child becomes an orphan, having lost one or both parents to HIV/AIDS. Children's lives are unraveling as parents, teachers, doctors, and other community leaders succumb to AIDS. Children are caring for children. Others must depend on ailing grandparents. Sadly, they have little to hope for beyond daily survival.

# Your assistance.

With your support, local churches and community networks of caring adults will be equipped with training and resources to make home care visits to orphans and widows affected by HIV/AIDS. Health care, education, and basic necessities will no longer be out of reach for these suffering children.
